TOWN COUNCIL MEETING  
MARCH 10, 2025

The Mayor and Board of Alderman of the Town of Mansura met on Monday, March 10, 2025, at six o'clock.

The meeting opened with a prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Present: Mayor Kenneth Pickett, Alderman Glenn Mckinley, Bruce Jackson, Alderwoman Judy James, and Judy Bazert.

Absent: Roderick Perry

Due to Mr. Thomas David not making the meeting, Mr. Rhett Desselle from Pan American Engineers presented the Mayor and Board of Alderman with some updates on water system improvements, Splash Pad, Bayou Lacombe, and LGAP applications.

Mayor Pickett addressed the Board of Alderman about the LAWCO franchise agreement coming up and the possibility of purchasing the water company.

Motioned by Judy Bazert, seconded by Bruce Jackson and unanimously carried for town engineer to send a letter to LAWCO to gauge interest in the possibility of selling to the town.

Mrs. Augustine addressed the Mayor and Board of Alderman about the Pavillion Rental for graduation parties.


The Mayor and Board of Alderman informed Mrs. Augustine that the Pavilion is not to be rented out for graduation parties per ordinance.

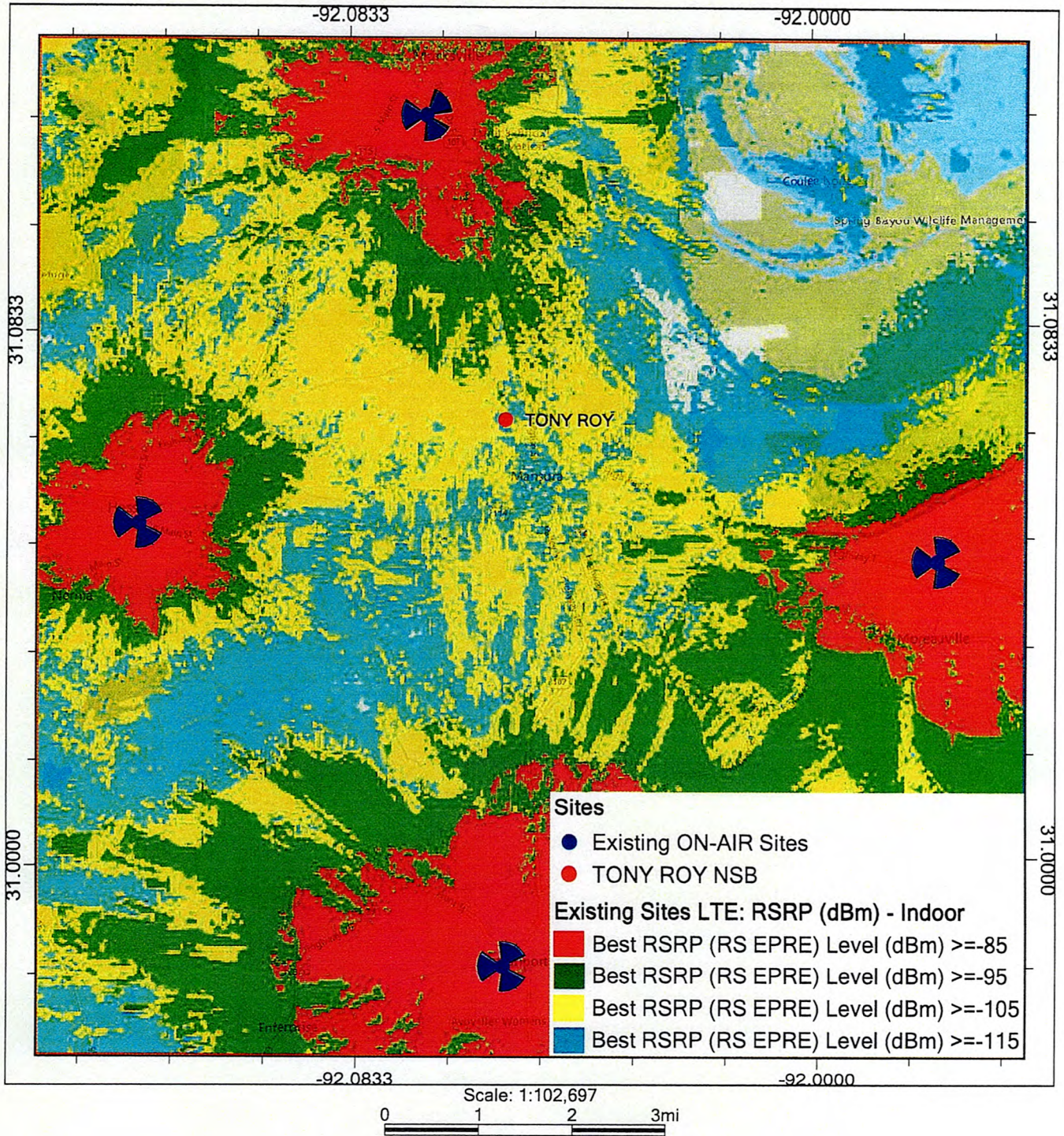

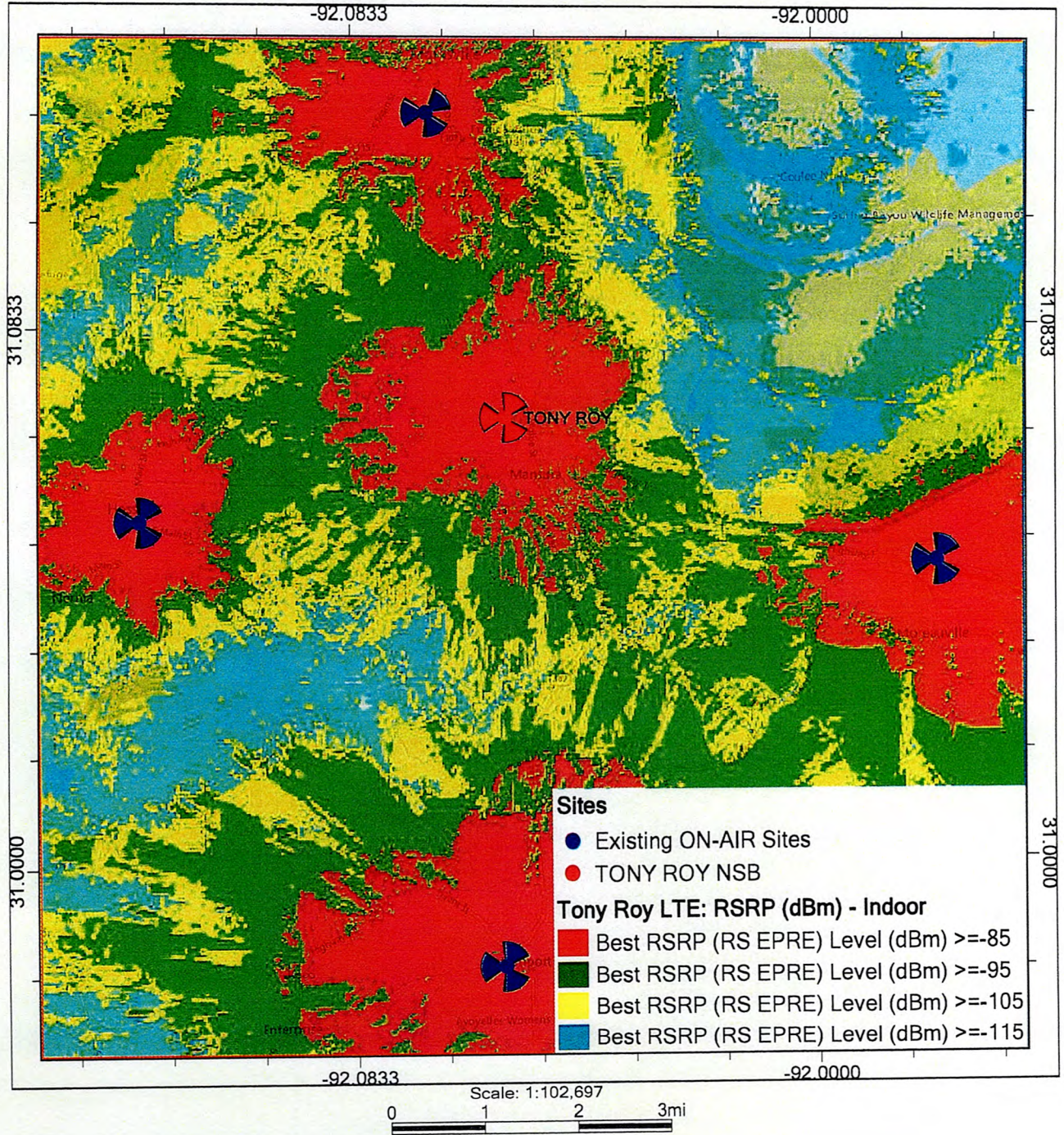
